

PCA&D Articulation Agreement

Pennsylvania College of Art & Design is pleased to enter into this Articulation Agreement with **Eastern Center for Arts and Technology**. This agreement will facilitate the transition from ECAT to PCA&D for students who successfully graduate from Eastern Center for Arts and Technology under the following terms:

1. Students will have earned their secondary school diploma with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA from ECAT
2. Students will have successfully demonstrated art and design competencies in a portfolio of artwork that meets PCA&D's admission criteria
3. Students will have completed all necessary steps in the PCA&D admissions process

Upon successful completion of the terms specified above, ECAT enrolled at PCA&D under this agreement will receive:

1. Three transfer credits to be allocated in students' BFA program to meet the requirements for Studio Electives, leaving 117 remaining credits to be successfully completed for awarding of the BFA degree at PCA&D

This agreement will remain active and in effect from September, 2019 through June 2022 but may be cancelled with six months written notice by either institution. In the event of termination of this agreement, students whose studies are in progress at PCA&D will be permitted to complete the degree program under the agreement terms.
