**Articulation Agreement  
Between Pennco Tech and Eastern Center for Arts and Technology  
Automotive Technology Degreed Program**

This Letter of Agreement has been enacted to facilitate the continuation of students from Eastern Center for Arts and Technology to Pennco Technical Institute (Pennco Tech) for the 2020-2021 school years. This agreement creates a systematic and seamless process in which students can move from high school to Pennco Tech without having to duplicate efforts or repeat courses.

**1. Articulated Course(s)**

This agreement enables Eastern Center for Arts and Technology students to receive Pennco Tech credit and advanced standing in the Automotive Technology Degreed Program. The following Pennco Tech course is identified as the course to be considered for articulation purpose as determined by the respective instructional staffs.

**2. Instructional Representatives**

**3. Procedure**

A. Applicants for advanced standing from Eastern Center for Arts and Technology must meet Pennco Tech admissions requirements and must have been admitted to Pennco Tech prior to participation in the articulation process.

B. Students must enroll at Pennco Tech within 27 months from his/her high school graduation date to receive articulated credit. This allows the student two years and a summer to use his/her credit.

C. Students must provide an official high school transcript, which reflects a passing grade of B, or higher in their course/s to be granted articulation credit.

D. This agreement between Eastern Center for Arts and Technology and Pennco Tech must be renewed each year or if there is an instructor change at the high school.

E. Institutional representatives from Pennco Tech and Eastern Center for Arts and Technology agree to evaluate the articulation process bi-annually.
